- 5 Say what you will do in the future to keep well (e.g. go to bed earlier, go to the gym).

- 5 Ask when breakfast is tomorrow.

- 5 Say you learn German at school.

You are talking to your Swiss friend about holidays.

Your teacher will play the part of your Swiss friend.

You will speak first.

- 1 Ask your friend what he/she does on holiday.
- 2 Say you like Switzerland.
- 3 Say where you went last year on holiday.
- 4 Say how long for and with whom.
- 5 Say what you would like to do on holiday in the future.

Where you live

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about where you live.

Your teacher will play the part of your exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say where you live (give **two** details).
- 2 Say whether you like living there or not.

- 4 Say how often you go into town.
- 5 Say what you did in your area last weekend.

Conversation at the train station

- 2 Say when you would like to travel.

- 5 Say you find Berlin interesting.
